Year 4 Curriculum - Spring Term 1.

<u>English</u> - This term we will be reading the Folk Tale 'The Lancashire Giant.' The children will be describing settings in the story, and will be writing their own story based on the text we are reading. The children will then move on to 'recounts' looking at Newspaper reports.

The children will explore the use of fronted adverbials for when; dialogue; use of commas; pronouns; paragraphs and noun phrases.

<u>Maths</u> - The children will be continuing with multiplication and will explore multiplication of 2,3,4 digit numbers with a single digit. They will also explore multiplying multiples of 100 with a single digit number. Towards the end of half term, we will be looking at pictograms, bar and line graphs. The children will also continue with daily practice of times tables in readiness for the MTC.

Religious Education - This term our topic is all about Jesus. The children will explore reasons as to why Christians believe Jesus to be the Son of God. Within this unit, the children will also be looking at the Jewish celebrations of the Sabbath.

<u>French</u> - In French this term, the children will be continuing to develop conversation, and will be looking at numbers to 20 and months of the years.

<u>Geography</u> - This term our topic is 'The United Kingdom.' The children will be looking at countries within the UK, as well as major counties, cities and towns.

<u>Art</u> - This half term we will be continuing to develop our drawing and painting skills.

<u>Science</u> - In Science our topic is 'Sound.' The children will think about how sounds are created and carry out various experiments to show vibrations in sound.

PE / Games - Swimming on Thursday mornings.

<u>Music</u> - In Music we follow the Charanga scheme. This half term we will be looking at 'Rap music' and we will focus on the rap 'Stop Bullying.' The

children will learn the song, and will have a try at writing a rap of their own. They will also listen to other rap songs by various artists.

<u>Computing-</u> In computing we will be looking at digital images. The children will be taught how to rotate, crop and recolour images. We will also be looking at 'Online Reputation' in our safety sessions.
