Dogs have feelings and needs and it's important that we respect them and behave kindly and safely around them.

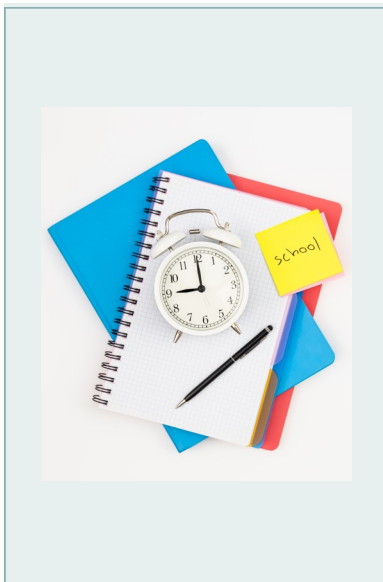
