YEAR 2: Megan Williams for a great understanding of why Jesus washed his disciples feet before the Last Supper.

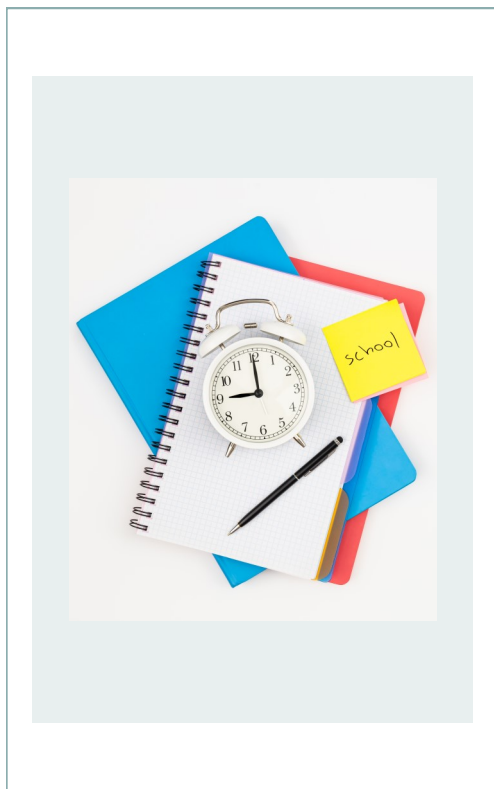
YEAR 3: Roan Street for having the courage to speak up in class and tell the RE inspector about the key vocabulary in God's big story!
